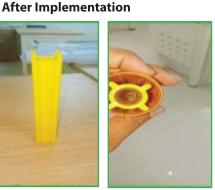

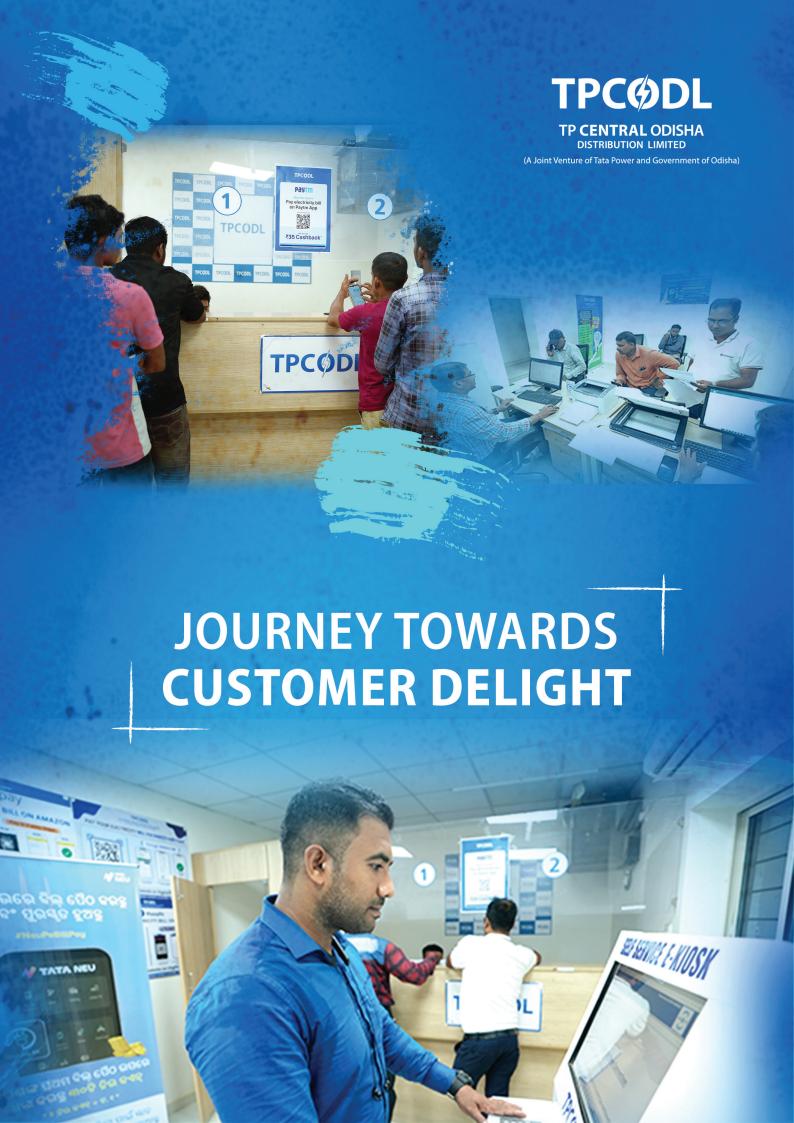














Prize Distribution Ceremony under Bill Pay & Win Scheme

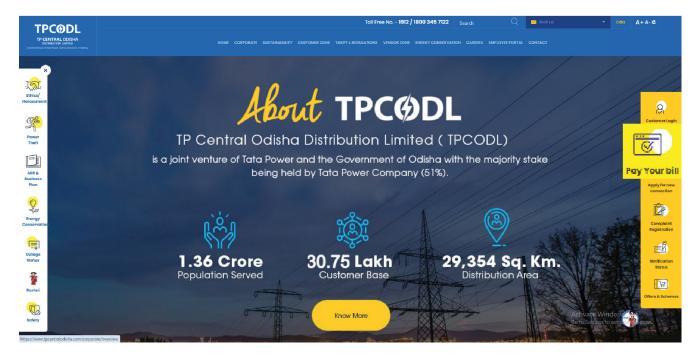

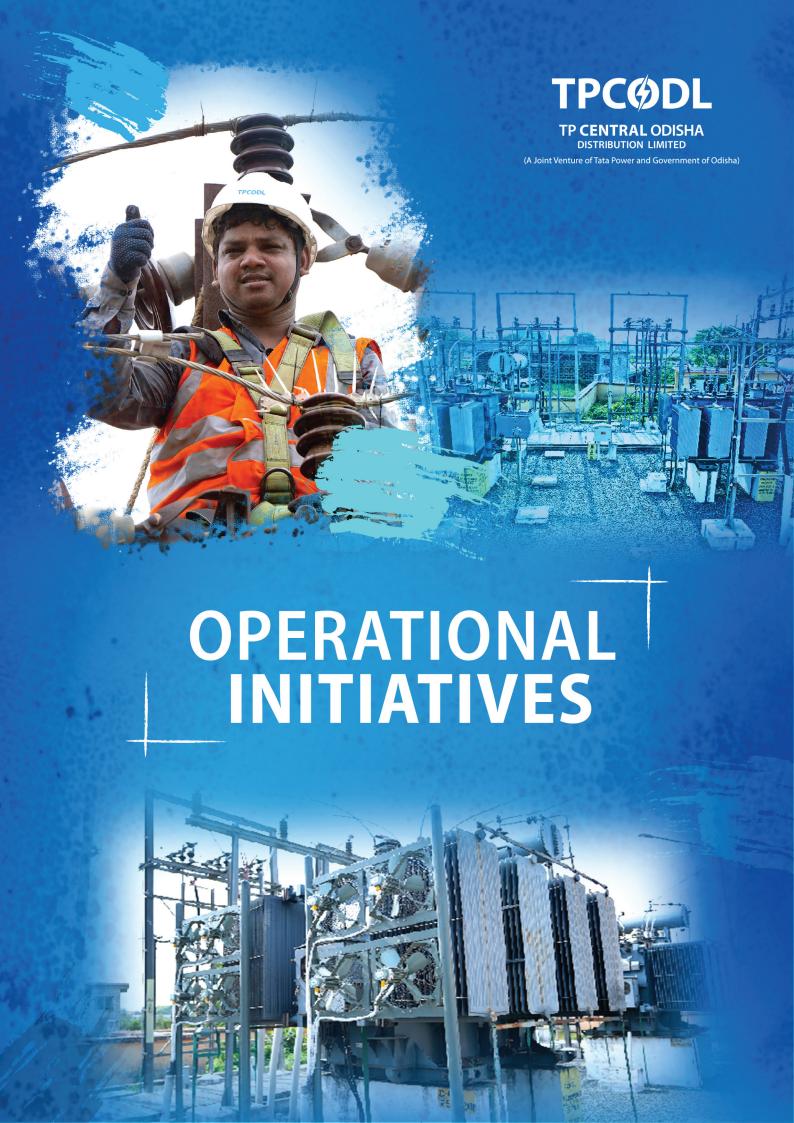


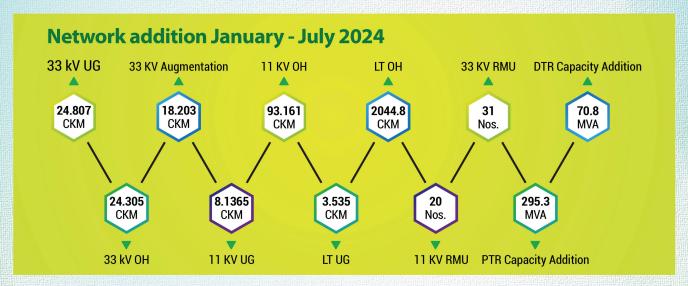












Technologies Adopted by TPCODL

Advanced Cable Fault Locator: TPCODL has inducted the new Centrix Cable Fault Locator into its system. This Fault Locating Crew Test van represents the most advanced and upgraded version of cable test equipment, equipped with a Very Low Frequency of 0.1Hz.





SCADA Integration: TPCODL has carried out SCADA integration of the 33 kV RMU in Bhubaneswar, enhancing real-time monitoring and control.



Lightning Surge Diverters: To reduce Distribution Transformer (DTR) failures, lightning surge diverters have been installed on overhead feeders.



Kalbaisakhi Preparedness

In preparation for the Kalbaisakhi season, TPCODL has implemented additional measures to ensure the early restoration of power supply:

 Deployment of Resources: Additional manpower and vehicles are deployed to meet any emergencies.



Mobile Distribution Substations: 9 mobile distribution substations are available.



 Material Stocking: 20 divisional stores, in addition to 5 circle stores, have been created with adequate materials.

Emergency Materials: Poles, conductors, and LT ABC are available at the section level.





Tree Cutting/Trimming: Separate agencies have been deployed for tree cutting and trimming across the region.





- Manlifters and Pole Masters: 5 manlifters are deployed for working at height, and pole masters are available to attend to emergencies.
- **ASKA Lights:** 20 ASKA lights are provided at vulnerable locations.



- **Emergency Control Rooms:** Division-wise emergency control rooms will be activated based on alerts received.
- Feeder Managers: Feeder managers with defined responsibilities for 11 kV feeder maintenance and preand post-disaster management have been identified.

Achievements

Low Voltage Pocket Solutions: To address low voltage pockets, 56 Power Transformers with On-load Tap Changers (OLTC) have been made functional, with about 15 OLTCs operational in auto mode.

Timely Energization: During Shree Mandira Parikrama Prakalpa the energization of Samanga Car Parking, AC Hanger, and JBPC Multiple Level Car Parking was completed in record time.

Event Support: TPCODL ensured safe and reliable power supply during the Shree Mandira Parikrama Prakalpa event.

These initiatives and achievements demonstrate TPCODL's commitment to adopting advanced technologies and ensuring robust preparedness for seasonal challenges, all while maintaining a focus on reliable service delivery and safety.

TP Central Odisha Distribution Ltd (TPCODL), a joint venture between Tata Power and the Government of Odisha, is proud to announce its successful efforts in powering the Puri Jagannath Heritage Corridor. This project aims to enhance the infrastructure for devotees visiting Puri, one of the country's most sacred pilgrimage sites.

The extensive development of a robust electrical system for the heritage corridor includes multi-level car parking at Jail Road, parking at Jagannath Ballava Pilgrim Centre, Mahodadhi Market Complex, Municipality Market Complex, AC Hangar and EV charging infrastructure at Samanga parking place.

Approximately 300 TPCODL officials worked tirelessly around the clock, managing all changeover points and 33/11kV Primary Substations (PSS) for preventive maintenance of feeders and substations in the town. Their efforts included leakage current testing and ensuring N-1 power supply arrangements across all voltage levels.

TPCODL has reinforced its operational capacity to ensure high-quality service. Key measures include strengthening all critical Primary Substations (PSS) and upgrading the Power Transformer (PTR) at the 33/11kV Talabania PSS from 8 MVA to 12.5/16 MVA to accommodate increasing load growth. Additionally, 11kV and 33kV relay settings have been adjusted at the 33/11kV PSS to meet future load requirements, and arrangements have been made for charging buses.

In line with TPCODL's commitment to safety, fire extinguishers were installed at all critical installations, including PSS, Compact Substations (CSS) and Distribution Substations (DSS). This initiative aims to maintain a safe work environment and protect infrastructure. The company also ensured that all temporary electrical connections were properly metered. As a result, 23 connections have been provided to meet power demands of approximately 2200 KW across 15 locations.

TPCODL's efforts underscore its dedication to improving infrastructure, ensuring reliable power supply and maintaining safety standards for the benefit of all devotees visiting the Puri Jagannath Heritage Corridor.







Reliability Improvements in Bhubaneswar City

TPCODL is committed to ensuring a reliable and efficient power supply for the residents of Bhubaneswar. In Q4 significant advancements and infrastructure upgrades were undertaken to enhance the city's power reliability and prepare for increased summer demands. Here are the key highlights of our recent efforts.

 Installation and Commissioning of Power Transformers: TPCODL successfully installed and commissioned five 16 MVA, 33/11 kV power transformers.



- New Switchgear and Control Rooms: Three 11 kV indoor switchgears were installed and commissioned along with new control rooms at Infocity, Laxmisagar and Khandagiri PSS.
- Second 33 kV Source to Uttara PSS: TPCODL commissioned a second 33 kV source to Uttara PSS from OPTCL's Pratapsasangrid. This project involved crossing the Puri Highway at RI Chowk using the HDD method and laying 33 kV cables along the highway adjacent to GAIL's high-pressure gas pipeline.
- Second 33 kV Source to Pandra PSS: A second 33 kV source to Pandra PSS was successfully commissioned. This project included online cable terminations on the 33 kV tower of Rasulgarh UG PHD feeder, crossing the National Highway at Kuwakhaiflyover bridge using the HDD method and laying 33 kV cables along with an overhead line.
- Barang Feeder Upgrade: TPCODL completed the overhead to underground cable conversion of 2.2 cktkms of the 33 kV Barang feeder near KIIT. This upgrade replaces the 100 sq.mm overhead conductor with 630 sq.mm cables, improving reliability and eliminating unsafe conditions due to the low height of the 33 kV overhead line at KIIMS hospital, KIIT college and adjoining areas.
- Interlinking of Nayapalli-Barmunda and Ransinghpur-Nayapalli Lines: The interlinking of the 33 kV Nayapalli-Barmunda line and the 33 kV Ransinghpur-Nayapalli line through 33 kV cables and two 33 kV RMUs installed at VIP colony was completed. This interlinking helps mitigate load due to overloading of the 33 kV Chandaka-Nayapalli line.
- Feeder Upgradation: Four 33 kV feeders between OPTCL's GSS and TPCODL's PSS at Mancheswar B were upgraded by replacing 1Cx400 sq.mm cables with 1Cx630 sq.mm cables along with GIS end terminations, as part of load mitigation during the summer.

- RMU Installations: TPCODL installed and commissioned 15 33 kV RMUs and 24 11 kV RMUs as part of various schemes finalized by NEG and PSCC to improve the reliability of power supply in Bhubaneswar city and mitigate load as part of summer preparedness. This project also involved laying 59 kms of 33 kV underground cables, stringing 27 cktkms of 33 kV overhead lines, laying 26 kms of 11 kV underground cables and stringing 17 cktkms of 11 kV overhead lines.
- Distribution Transformer Swapping: The swapping of 84 distribution transformers was completed (250 kVA to 500 kVA - 27 nos., 100 kVA to 250 kVA - 19 nos., 63 kVA to 100 kVA - 21 nos., 25



kVA to 63 kVA - 17 nos.). Additionally, 56 LTDBs were installed and 13.3 kms of LT ABC were strung at various locations identified by Operations for mitigating load as part of summer preparedness.

Revamping of Bhimtangi PSS Switchyard for Enhanced Safety and Reliability

TPCODL has completed a major revamp of the Bhimtangi PSS switchyard to ensure safety, timely power restoration and uninterrupted supply. Key upgrades include:

- **Transformer Upgrade:** Replaced the 8MVA power transformer with a new 12.5/16 MVA unit, including a new foundation capable of supporting 30 tonnes.
- Yard Improvements: Implemented plain cement concreting and gravel spreading to control voltage levels and prevent weed growth.



• **Foundation Restoration:** Repaired old cracked foundations with concreting, plastering and painting.

TPCODL continues its commitment to enhancing infrastructure and ensuring reliable power supply to its customers, particularly in preparation for the increased demands during the summer months.

- Fire Prevention: Installed a NIFPS with BOT, soak pit and firewall to safeguard against fire hazards.
- Equipment Management: Returned unused PTRs, cables and other equipment to the store for easier access and faster response times.
- Cable Management: Constructed new power and control cable trenches for quicker replacement during faults and reduced damage.





Major Initiatives in Q1 FY 24-25

1. TMU Commissioning: Successfully commissioned 40 new Transformer Monitoring Units (TMUs).



- 2. BCPU Installations: Replaced electromagnetic relays with 37 new Battery Current Protection Units (BCPUs).
- 3. GIS PSS Commissioning: Commissioned the 33/11 kV Badagada Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) Power Substation under the SCRIPS initiative.







4. Power Transformer Upgrades: Refurbished 9

Power Transformers (PTRs) and upgraded 8 PTRs with an additional capacity of 44.4 MVA.

7. Distribution Transformer Enhancements: Upgraded or added 406 Distribution Transformers (DTRs) with a total capacity increase of 43.855 MVA.



5. Wedge Connectors: Installed 648 wedge connectors.



6. HT Sleeve, Tape, and Bird Guards: Installed 0.4 km of HT sleeve, 51 rolls of HT tape and 1864 bird guards.





8. DT Suraksha Program: Executed oil top-ups (7 KL), load balancing (542 units) and lightning arrester installations (403 units).





TPCODL Ensures Reliable Power Supply and Public Safety During Puri Ratha Yatra

TPCODL successfully met the load of 73 MW expected in Puri Town during the CAR Festival with an installed capacity of 169 MVA. Four PTRs were augmented from 8 MVA to 12.5/16 MVA, ensuring better load management. The existing 33kV network was strengthened to ensure N-2 redundancy and reliable power supply.

TPCODL deployed a workforce of 800 employees, including TPCODL staff, Business Associates and Switchgear experts from TPCODL and OEMs, to ensure uninterrupted and



quality power supply during the festival. Extensive preventive maintenance of 33/11 KV PSS, HT and LT Switchgears and the OH and Underground network was conducted, along with condition monitoring. Critical equipment and materials such as cable fault locators, mobile transformers, cranes, man lifters, distribution transformers and a sufficient stock of transformers and oil were kept ready to meet any exigency.

All Primary Substations were manned with skilled TPCODL employees round the clock. A master control room at Talabania monitored the overall power situation, with special control rooms activated at six strategic locations: Paschimadwar, Saradhabali Bidyut Seva Kendra, Mobile Patrolling Group at Sriram Nagar, Malatipatpur, Sea Beach and Talabania.

Ideation Workshop

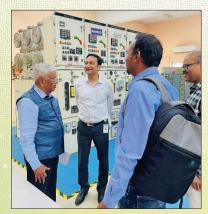

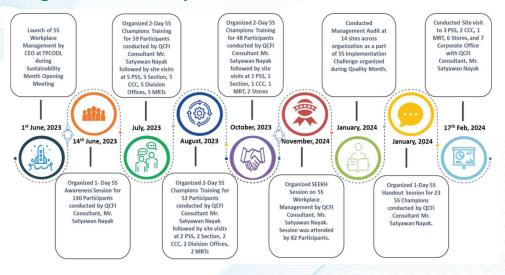






5S Workplace Management Journey in FY'24

It began with a written test to assess participants' understanding of 5S concepts, followed by 5-8 minute presentations from the 5S Champions on their implementation experiences. A total of 23 5S Champions attended the session.

Club Enerji Program

From January to June 2024, TPCODL organized Mega Urja Melas in Bhubaneswar, Angul and Paradip, bringing together stakeholders such as the District Education Department (GoO), UNICEF, Tata Steel, TCS and Aditya Birla. The event focused on energy conservation and green energy promotion. Competitions like Best Out of Waste, Science Exhibition, Slogan Writing and Painting aimed to raise awareness. Interactive games on Sustainable Development Goals added engagement, fostering a deeper understanding of sustainability among participants.

Women Literacy Center (VIDYA)

Under the aegis VIDYA, 25 Women Literacy Centers have been set up across our operational areas, providing literacy education to women. Using TCS's informal Education Module, these centers teach functional, digital, and financial literacy in the Odiya language, focusing on rural and slum areas.

From January to March 2024, 1,000 women in urban slums across Bhubaneswar, Puri and Cuttack completed Basic Functional Literacy Courses. Currently, in Q1 FY 24-25, 500 women are enrolled in these programs which are designed to improve their quality of life and community participation.





Vocational Training Center (ROSHNI)

TPCODL's commitment to holistic rural development is evident through the establishment of two Vocational Training Centers. By March 2024, 300 trainees have completed NSDC-certified courses in Stitching, Tailoring and Basic Computer Skills, with 100 youths trained in Spoken English. In Q1 FY 24-25, 50 women are enrolled in these courses, gaining skills to become self-reliant and financially independent. The Stitching and Tailoring course has already led to 38 job placements in the garment industry.

Additionally, the center has expanded into jute material production, with 20 women trained to create products like jute bags and folders. Expert-led sessions from the Jute Board have ensured these women are equipped with the skills needed to thrive in sustainable industries.









Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Center (DAKSH)

TPCODL has established a Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Center in Angul, offering NSDC-certified training in facility management and security guard roles. To date, 120 students have been trained in plumbing and facility management courses, with all the graduates securing job placements. In FY 24-25, the center will train another 120 individuals in facility management and secutity guard courses, equipping them with the skills needed for stable employment. Graduates will receive NSDC certification, enhancing their job prospects in various industries.













EV Technician Training Center (DAKSH)

TPCODL has pioneered the EV Technician Training initiative in Odisha, preparing a skilled workforce for green jobs. 60 students have completed NSDC-certified courses, gaining hands-on experience through simulator-based training and industrial visits. All the trainees have secured employment, highlighting the program's success. A comprehensive compendium documents the transformative journeys of these trainees, showcasing the program's impact.













Local Artisan Cluster (SAMRIDDHI)

TPCODL's ocal Artisian CLuster is training 240 women artisans in Palm Leaf Carving and Pattachitra under the guidance of National Award Winning Master Trainers. An Art Cum Sale Gallery has also been established to showcase and sell their creations, securing livelihoods and empowering these artisans with marketing skills. By participating in local and national fairs, these women are fostering independent identities while promoting traditional art within their communities.









Integrated Farming Cluster (SAMRIDDHI)

TPCODL has established an Integrated Farming Cluster in Nayagarh, training 600 farmer households across 3 blocks. The initiative includes 10 Aqua Culture Farmer Producer Groups and the adoption of 362 farm ponds over 300 hectares. To support farmers, Cluster Information Centers and Satellite Technical Centers have been set up for information dissemination and linking to government schemes. Additionally, user-friendly Farm Record Books and Farming Training Manuals in the local language have been released to aid crop multiplication.







Mobile Health Dispensary (AAROGYA)

TPCODL's four Mobile Health Dispensaries have provided doorstep healthcare to over 130,000 people across 2,600+ villages. More than 360 Health Awareness Campaigns on topics like Malaria prevention, Menstrual Hygiene and Basic Cancer Awareness have also been conducted. To further support rural communities, TPCODL signed an MoU with Tata Trusts to extend these services to the weaver community in Maniabandh. A Mega Health Camp was conducted in Q1 FY24-25 for this community, marking a significant step in improving healthcare access for vulnerable groups.







Dhokra Metal Craft Cluster (SAMRIDDHI)

Under the 'SAMRIDDHI' initiative, a new Dhokra Metal Craft Cluster has been established in Nuagaon, Dhenkanal, to promote and preserve local craftsmanship. In FY 24-25 specialized training is underway for 100 rural craftsmen to enhance skills and modernize designs. This cluster aims to provide sustainable livelihoods, boost economic empowerment and preserve Odisha's rich heritage. Collaboration with NABARD, OLM, ORMAS and KALA PUNARUTTHAN Federation will further increase sales and program impact.











Adhikaar - Facilitating Access to Government Entitlements

In our ongoing effort to enhance inclusivity and ensure that essential services reach every corner of our community, TPCODL's flagship program, 'ADHIKAAR' has been rolled out in pilot basis at Daspala (Nayagarh). This initiative is designed to facilitate for access to Government entitlement and schemes as per the eligibility for the community members, aligning with our vision of working closely with marginalized and remote communities.





Volunteering Activities

TPCODL's volunteering efforts have positively impacted lives and the environment. 'Mission Jeevan' saw six blood donation camps across Nimapara, Marshaghai, Salepur, CDD-I, Puri and Nayagarh Divisions, collecting 307 units of blood with support from the Indian Red Cross Society and District Blood Bank. The initiative has been widely praised on social media for its selfless impact.

In line with promoting sustainability, various events were held, including Plogging, Seed Ball Making, Nature Trails and Plantation Drives. On World Environment Day, over 300 saplings were planted. A Mega Plogging Drive at Shikarchandi, Bhubaneswar recycled 15+ kg of plastic waste.

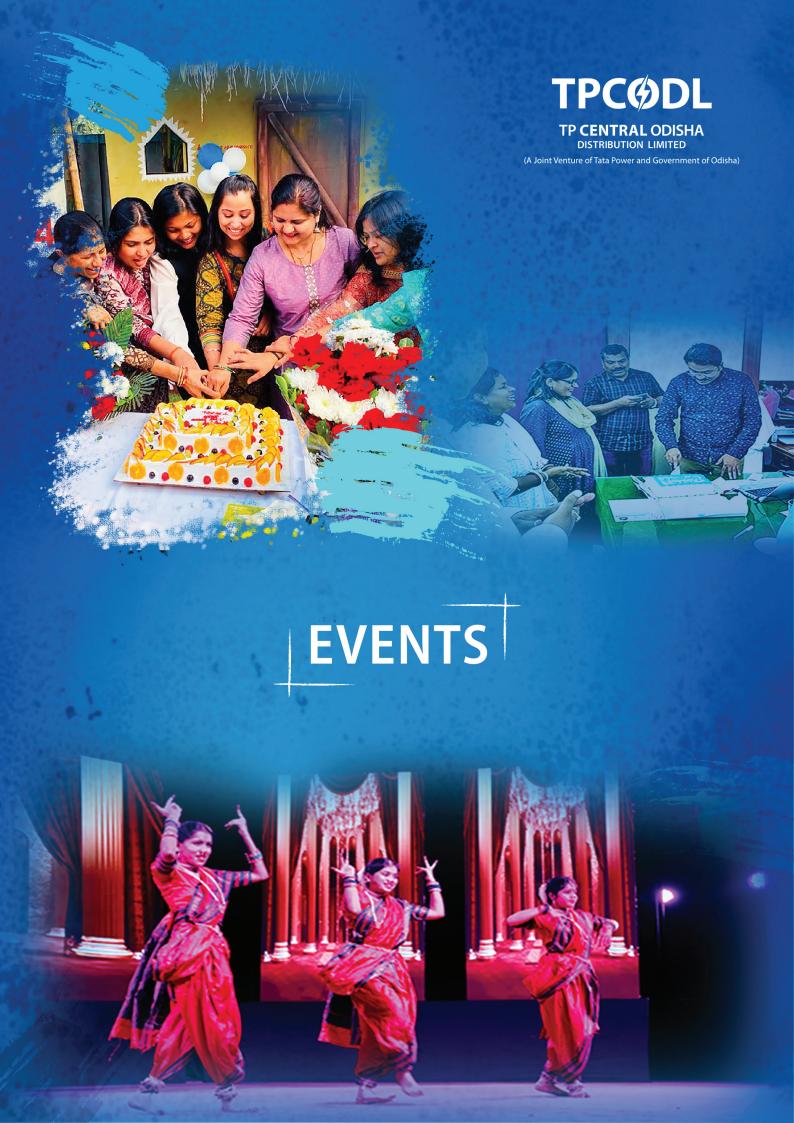














New Year Celebrations Across TPCODL

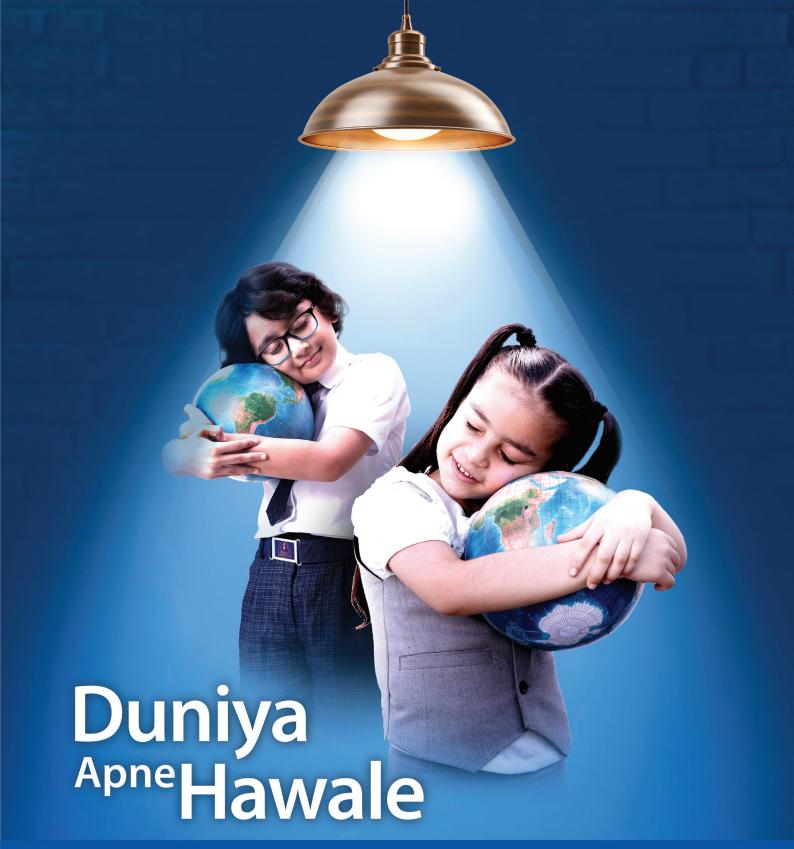
