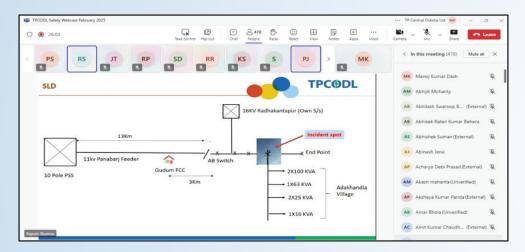


Leadership at the Helm: Safety Starts at the Top

Our leadership continues to set the tone for a strong safety culture, turning strategy into action and vision into impact.

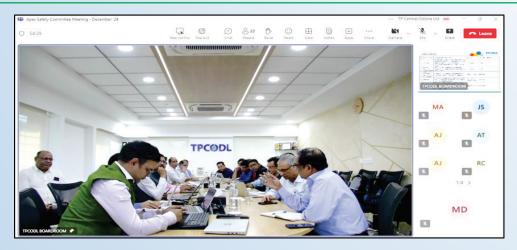


Monthly Safety Webcasts by the CEO and senior leaders kept teams aligned on key safety metrics and reinforced individual accountability.

Raising the Bar on PPE Compliance

Our "100% PPE Compliance" campaign focused on creating lasting behavioural change — not just ticking boxes.



Structured audits at PSS and worksites followed by on-the-spot coaching helped address gaps in awareness and gear availability.



A **digital PPE Matrix** gave field teams quick clarity on task-specific requirements.



Focus on **Critical Activity Unsafe Practices (CAUP)** through demos and discussions reinforced why safety shortcuts aren't worth the risk.



Greater use of **voltage detectors**, **Neon Testers and double harnesses** is driving safer work habits across the board.















Strengthening Supervision and Field Oversight

To ensure safety at high-risk sites, TPCODL made on-site supervision mandatory for jobs involving 12+ workers — rural or urban.













Over **453 BA Supervisors** underwent online competency evaluations to ensure only trained personnel lead critical tasks.



Permit to Work (PTW) protocols are strictly enforced, with trainees barred from supervisory roles.

This move ensures faster risk response and safer execution on the ground.

Celebrating Safety Month with Heart and Purpose

In March 2025, we marked the 54th National Safety Day with a month-long campaign themed *"Safety and Well-being Crucial for Viksit Bharat."* From flag hoisting to safety pledges, we kicked off the celebrations across all offices simultaneously.

What made it truly special was the involvement of our employees' families — children and spouses joined in with posters, slogans and home safety ideas. Their participation reminded us that safety isn't just a workplace value — it's a way of life.













Gamifying Safety: Learning Made Fun

To boost engagement, we introduced fun safety activities like *Safety Bingo*, online quizzes and crossword puzzles. These interactive challenges turned daily safety checks into team-building moments and encouraged peer-to-peer learning across departments.

Safety Science Fair

Our first-ever *Safety Science Fair saw* children of employees showcase innovative, safety-driven projects mentored by our Safety Officers. From smart traffic systems to life-saving ideas, their creativity reminded us that safety is more than a rule — it's a legacy we pass on.

We introduced high-impact trainings including VR-based safety modules, SHE L1 & L2 for BA employees and CPR, first-aid and fire safety sessions. The Train-the-Trainer program by Dale Carnegie further strengthened our Safety Officers' facilitation and communication skills.









Smart Tech, Safer Network

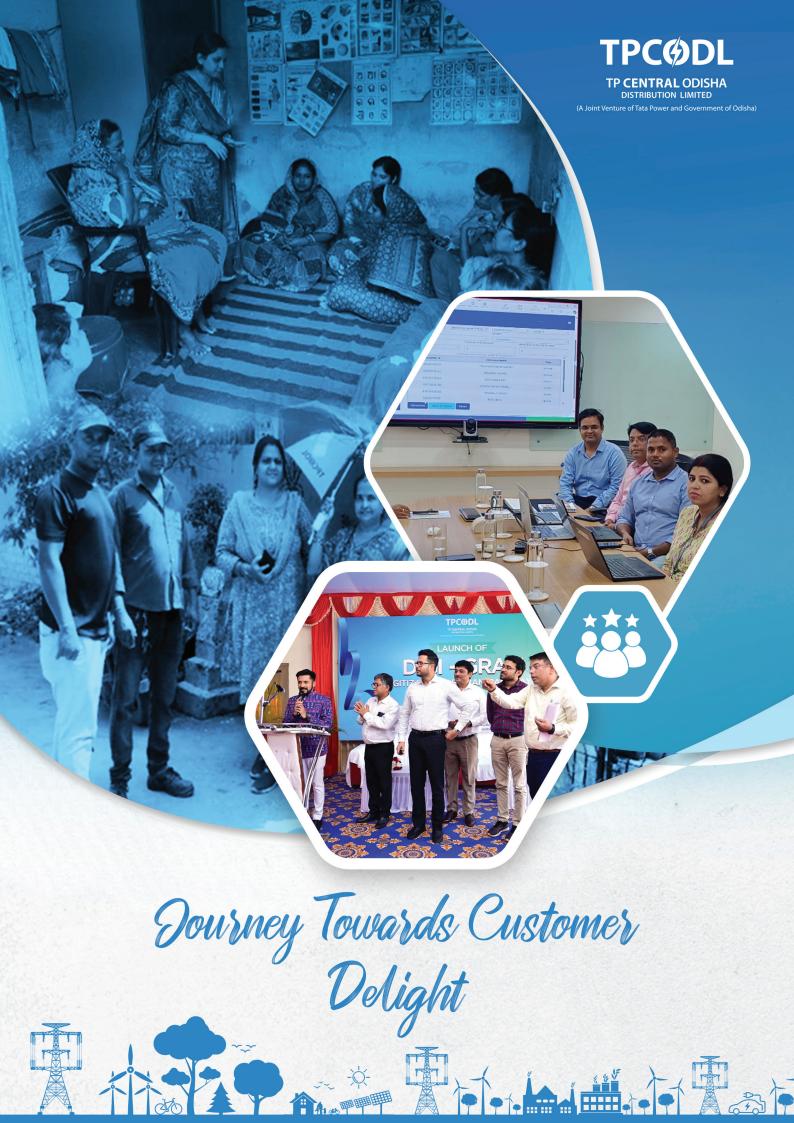
We continued integrating smart safety upgrades — from RYB reflective stickers on AB switches for better night visibility, to GIS-based tagging of unsafe poles. Fire-retardant tape on overhead cables and helmet-mounted voltage detectors are further steps toward proactive risk elimination.

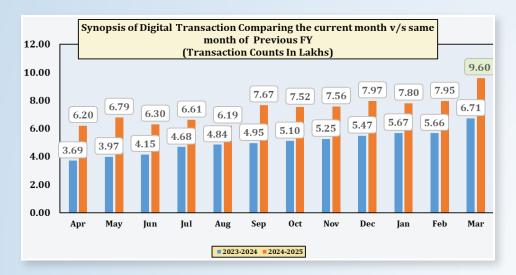

At the Service of the Consumer: The Four Pillars of Meter Management at TPCODL

At TPCODL, we believe metering is the foundation of reliable power distribution. Our Meter Management Group (MMG) is more than a support function—it's a key enabler of transparency, accountability and customer satisfaction, all while following the highest safety standards.

From new installations to replacements, from HT readings to testing, our team ensures metering quality across consumer categories, transformers and feeders. We also monitor high-value consumers and conduct both on-site and lab-based testing.

MMG operates through four core pillars—**Field Installation, Lab Testing, AMI and MDAG**—each working in sync to deliver accuracy, efficiency and trust. Together, we drive technological progress and system reliability in every unit we power.

1. Field Installation: Empowering Consumers with Accurate Metering

Our Field Installation team plays a vital role in ensuring seamless metering across all consumer segments—from homes to HT industrial connections. In FY-25, we completed **5,06,040** metering activities, including **4,21,951** installations (comprising **3,76,682** single-phase and **45,269** three-phase meters). This marks a **36%** rise in installations and **28%** growth in overall activity over last year.

We also installed **2.02 lakh smart meters**, taking the total to **3.45 lakh**. With most **HTCT and LTCT meters now smart**, we aim to complete smart conversion of all 3-phase meters by **mid-FY'26**.

2. Lab Testing: Precision Beyond the Field

Our central labs ensure only the most accurate and reliable meters reach the field. Each meter undergoes rigorous testing to meet quality standards. Disputed or suspicious meters are also analysed for tampering, ensuring fairness, transparency and trust in every installation.

3. AMI: Smart Metering, Smarter Systems

Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) is revolutionizing metering by enabling real-time two-way communication between meters and the utility. With 3.45 lakh smart meters installed till FY-25 — including 2.02 lakh added this year — AMI has transformed remote reading, outage detection and billing accuracy. Focused efforts continue to resolve non-communication issues and achieve full 3-phase smart metering by mid-FY'26.

4. MDAG: Driving Insight with Data

The Meter Data Analysis Group (MDAG) decodes consumption patterns, identifies anomalies and supports decision-making for loss reduction and efficiency. Monitoring from HT consumers to transformers and feeders, MDAG's data-driven vigilance earned it the prestigious **Power Innovista Award (FY-25)** from the CEO & MD, Tata Power.

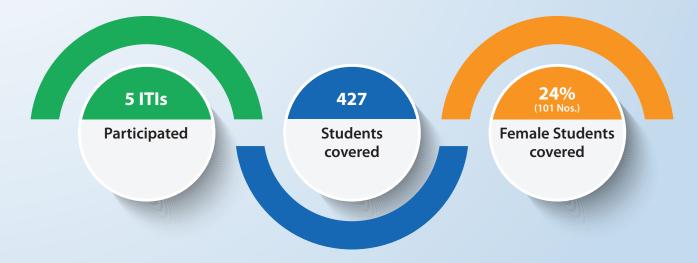

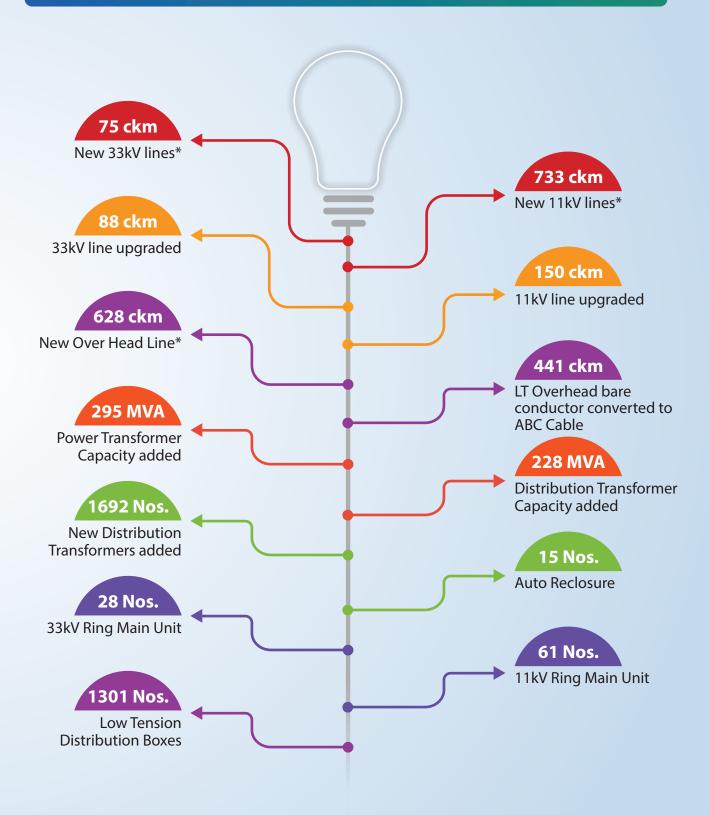

TP Central Odisha Distribution Limited (TPCODL), is prepared to meet the rising electricity demand as temperature soar in the summer of 2025.



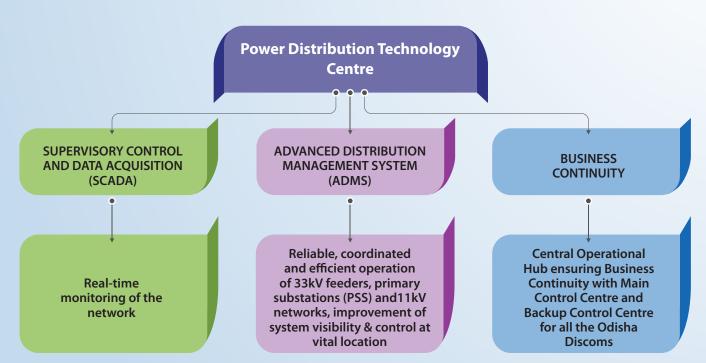
TPCODL has undertaken a series of proactive measures to ensure uninterrupted power supply and enhanced reliability.

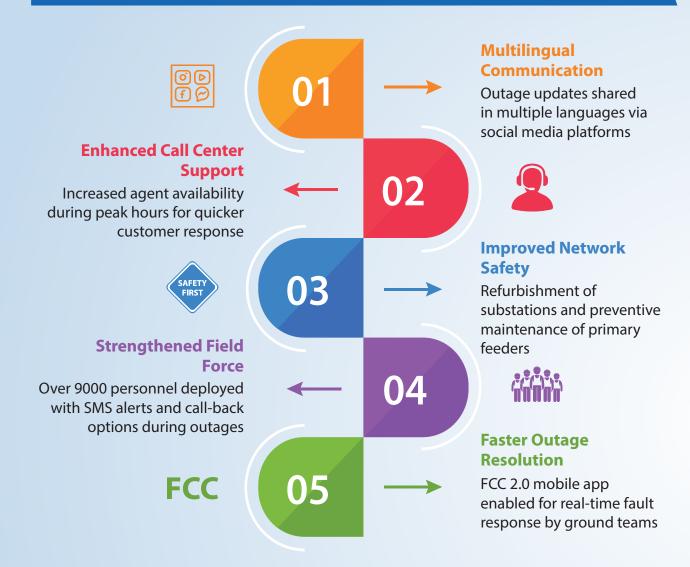

Policy Management

Strategy Formulation Workshop

We conducted our Strategy Formulation Workshop on 30th January 2025 at the Management Development Centre, Bhubaneswar. Functional leaders used the TQM Policy Management Approach to identify key focus areas—Safety, Billing Efficiency, Capitalization, Employee Engagement, Technology and Earned Credit Loss Liquidation (ECL). Guided by our CEO and CXOs, teams defined priority projects aligned with our strategic goals.

The outcomes have been integrated into the T&D Strategy and presented at the Tata Power Annual Strategy Workshop. With a clear roadmap, we are set to drive focused and sustained growth.















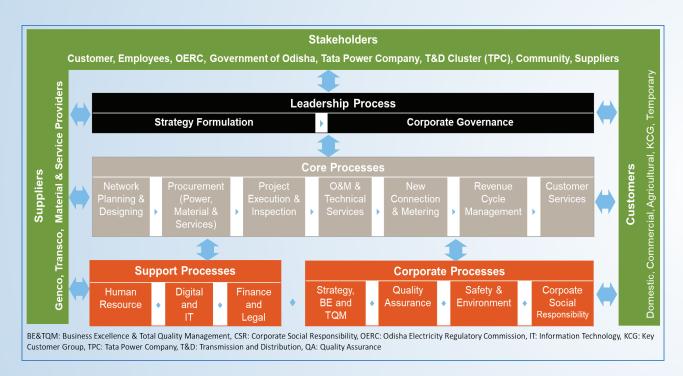
Daily Management

Process Reviews

We periodically review our processes under the SDCA cycle to ensure they reflect current practices and stay aligned with our Management and Control Plans. In Q4 of FY25, we reviewed and released updated versions of seven key processes:

Cable Fault Location and Repair (10.17.16 R01), Material Requirement Planning (10.24.04 R00), Enforcement Activity & Assessment (10.18.08 R03), Meter Testing at Site (10.18.11 R02), Meter Testing at Laboratory (10.18.10 R03), Meter Installation and Replacement (10.18.09 R05), HT & EHT Attribute Change (10.18.12 R01)

These updates help us maintain consistency, improve efficiency and support continuous improvement across operations.



IMS Internal Audits: Driving Process Excellence

In January 2025, IMS Internal Audits were conducted across key locations including Gabakunda, Rasulgarh, Bhatpada, Sainik School PSS, Janla Section and the Automation & Technology Group.

With active participation from 12 auditors and 30+ auditees, the audits focused on identifying process strengths, non-conformities and opportunities for improvement—reinforcing our commitment to continuous excellence.





Cross Functional Management

Mission 1201: A Historic Leap in Collections

Mission 1201 was a turning point for us at TPCODL. Through collective ownership, daily reviews and strong cross-functional collaboration, we achieved our highest-ever Collection Efficiency of 127.04% and Billing Efficiency of 84.69% in March 2025.

This success was the result of tireless efforts across our teams, with support from government departments and focused interventions at the ground level. It truly reflected what we can accomplish when we come together with purpose and passion.

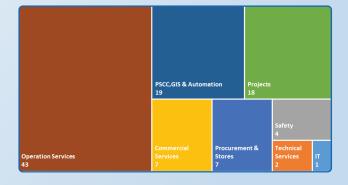






Annual QCC and Prayaas Competition
